Cause him/her to know that Jesus is the only hope for his/her deepest needs. I plead that _____ would know that He alone can quench _____'s thirst for forgiveness, blessedness, and wholeness. I ask that You would show him/her that He is the sufficient Savior. I plead that _____ would surrender to Jesus, receiving Him as his/her personal Lord and Savior.

Reveal to _____ Jesus' sufficiency to save and bless.

Wednesday: The Light Of The World (John 8:12)

Father, I thank You for Jesus. He is the Light of the world. It is only through Jesus that a person can understand who You are and his/her need of salvation.
