



Where's The Passion? Romans 10:1-4

God desires that believers have a passionate longing for the salvation of lost people. It is His will that believers pray for and witness to those who need Jesus. How can a believer lose this passionate longing for the souls of lost people?

(1) You lose your passion for the lost when your love for Jesus grows cold (Romans 10:1a).

It is an unchanging spiritual principle – when your love for Jesus grows cold, your love for the lost will also.

(2) You lose your passion for the lost when you do not pray for the lost (Romans 10:1b).

As you pray for the lost, God will enlarge your heart for those who are lost and in need of Jesus Christ.

(3) You lose your passion for the lost when you compromise the gospel (Romans 10:2-4).

The good news of Jesus is the only way that any person can be made right with God. It is only those who believe in Christ and surrender to Him that are truly saved and accepted by God.

Practical Applications:

- God desires that you have a passionate longing for those who need Jesus.
- Prayer is essential for the salvation of the lost.
- The uniqueness of Jesus should fuel your prayers for those who do not know Him.

What Is Prayerwalking?

Selected Scripture

(1) The Definition Of Prayerwalking.

- Prayerwalking is praying on-site with insight – praying on location for transformation.
- Insight for prayerwalking – revealed, responsive, and researched.

(2) The Reasons For Prayerwalking.

- It fulfills 1 Thessalonians 5:17.
- It creates compassion in believers (Matthew 9:36).
- It enables believers to pray in agreement (Matthew 18:18-20).
- It helps believers pray specifically (Matthew 7:7).
- It is crucial in reaching your community for Christ (Matthew 28:19-20).
- It releases God's power into your community (Jeremiah 32:17).



(3) The Basics of Prayerwalking.

- Ask God to teach you how to prayerwalk.
- Determine a location where you will prayerwalk.
- Enlist a partner(s).
- Go with prayer support.
- Pray according to what you see, hear, feel, and smell.
- Pray conversationally.
- Minister to people.
- Record your insights.
