Father, I pray that every obstacle to the gospel in _____ would be removed. Destroy anything that stands in the way of the people hearing and receiving the good news of Jesus Christ and His salvation (**2 Thessalonians 3:1-3**).

Father, I pray that You would raise up missionaries with a heart for _____. Place a burden on the hearts of believers to reach out to and win this nation for the Lord Jesus Christ. Equip them and send them into _____ so that they can reap

a harvest for the Lord Jesus Christ (**Matthew 9:35-37**).

Father, I ask You to strengthen the believers in _____. Give them the courage and the boldness to stand for You. Supply them with all that they need to live and stand for You. Pour out Your Holy Spirit on them. Draw them into a more intimate relationship with Yourself (**Acts 1-4**).

Father, I plead that _____ will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (**Habakkuk 2:14**).

Praying For Bible Translation

People need the Word of God if they are going to exercise saving faith (**Romans 10:17**). It is a necessity that people have a copy of the Word of God in their own language. Many peoples do not have a copy of the Word of God in their language. Others have only a partial translation of the Word of God. This requires Bible translators and diligent work. We should plead with God that the Word of God would be available in every continent, penetrating every people group, transforming the lives of countless people. The following prayer guide will help you to intercede concerning this great necessity. You can use this guide by placing the name of the nation or the people group in the blank.

Father, I pray that You would burden and call believers to translate the Bible into the

language of _____. Give them a heart for this work. Enable them to gain the education and the experiences that they will need for this work (**Matthew 9:37-38**).

Father, I ask You to strengthen and invigorate the spiritual lives of those translating the Bible in the language of _____. Grant them a growing and maturing knowledge of Your Word. Draw them into a more intimate relationship with Yourself (**Psalms 42:1-2**).

Father, I plead that You will protect the Bible translators for _____ from discouragement. I ask that You will give them skill and diligence in this matter. Cause them to be steadfast, immovable, and always abounding in the work of translation, knowing that their labor is not in vain (**1 Corinthians 15:58**).

I ask You to give good health to the Bible translators for _____. Strengthen them physically. Grant to them a clear and sound mind (**Exodus 15:26**).

Father, I ask You to bless the labors of the Bible translators for _____. I pray that You will enable them to translate the Bible into the language of _____ in the quickest possible time. Grant them everything that they need to do the work of translation. Let their translation be accurate and easily understood. Remove every obstacle that stands in the way of their work (**James 1:17**).

Father, I pray that You would prepare the hearts of _____ for the translation of the Scripture in their language. Grant them a hunger and a willingness to receive the Word of God (**Acts 16:14**).

Father, I plead that Your Word will run swiftly among _____ and be glorified as it transforms _____ (**2 Thessalonians 3:2**).
